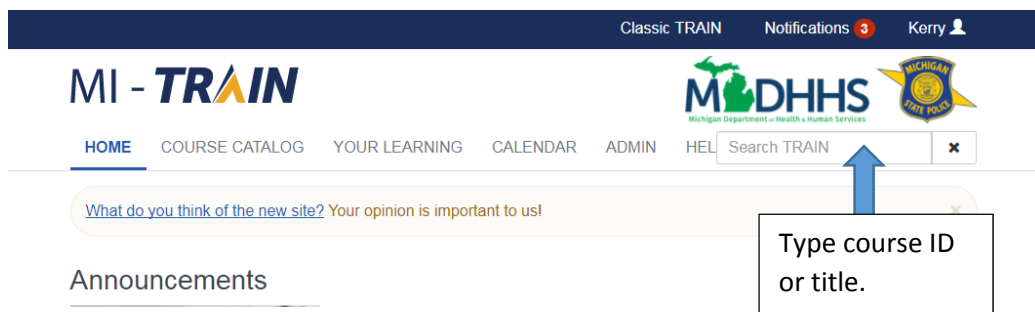
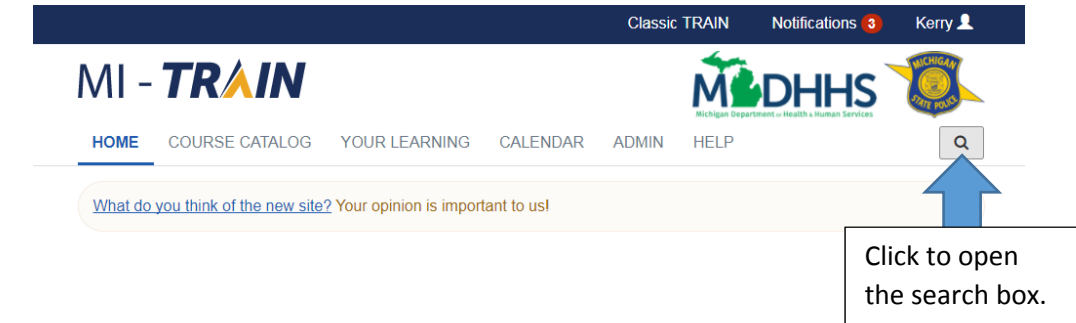
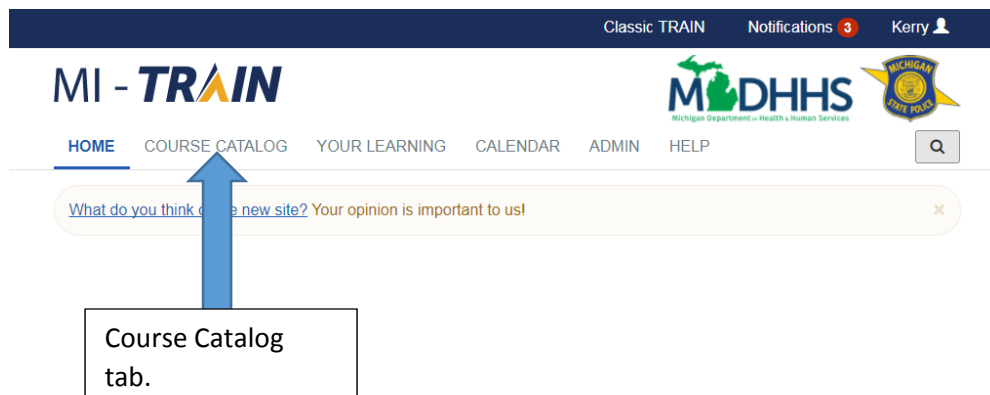


How to register for a course in MI-TRAIN 3.0

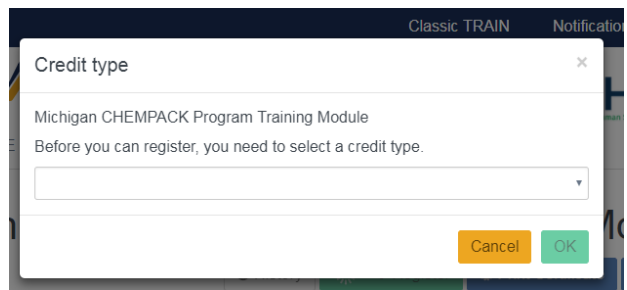
